Minutes of December 4, 2017

The monthly meeting of the Southeast Missouri Amateur Radio Club was called to order on Monday, December 4, 2017, at 1901 by President Klaus Mueller, WØLKE, with 26 members present.

Minutes of the last meeting were read by Acting Secretary Patty Chiles, ACØCU, and were approved as read.
