Minutes of October 1, 2012

The monthly meeting of the Southeast Missouri Amateur Radio Club was called to order on Monday, October 1, 2012, at 1903 by President Ernie Chiles, WØRMS, with 19 members and 1 visitor present.

Minutes of the last meeting were read by Secretary Karen Brewington, KDØJMO, and were approved as read.

Treasurer Judy Bradley, KCØWXS, reported that last month's balance was \$2,197.86. There were no transactions and the balance stands as \$2197.86. The treasurer's report was approved as read.

Old Business

Joe Lorberg, WAØZNI, said that he has been working on the new repeater controller that he purchased at a ham fest and has read up on the "300 page" manual. He has not hooked it up as of yet but if it is working, it appears to be what we need to replace the existing 146.685 controller. He still needs to do some more work on it to get it ready.

We will begin at 12 p.m. with a sack lunch and start the hunt at 1 pm. You will need to have a radio that you are able to change the frequency.

The Scout Jamboree on the Air will be on Saturday, October 20 at Klaus Park. Barry Doyle, ACØWL, has reserved the shelter. There could be as many as 40 boys working this event.
