Note's from my experience: (excludes Ham Repeaters- see seperate posted repeater list)

- 1- Cape Girardeau County Sheriff -155.4300MHz is not listed (it is confirmed Digital)
- 2- A dedicated scanner (ie. Uniden Bearcat) should be able to receive all frequencies listed
- 3- Some frequencies listed do include a "tone" transmission at times, followed up by voice signal
- 3- Those listed with "*" confirmed daily reception over several days (AD0WN@QTH w/CB125AT scanner)
- 4- Some Chinese HT's ie. UV-5R will not receive the AM Airport Frequencies- due to the frequency and mode (not FM)
- 5- If programming an HT beware... the scanning rate of the "Chinese" radios' scanning of frequencies is very slow. Recommend keeping those "programmed to scan" to a minimum "ie. less than 15 or so. A Slow Scan speed will impact the ability to detect an incoming signal in a timely manner. (other frequencies can be programmed into your radio but not programmed to "scan". In this situation, access would be by manually scrolling up or down the the contiguous channels of those you have programmed into the radio.
- 6-Baofeng UV-5R: when scanning, it is impossible to co-scan the other band (ie. A or B) that you have selected. For example, you have Cape's 2 Meter selected on A and are attempting to scan on B,-->only the pre-programmed scanned frequencies on B are being monitored, NOT the frequency displayed in "A". Some Japanese Radios' ie the Kenwood TH-F6 does enable simultaneousely monitoring both (has 2 receivers)
- 7- If your radio supports scanning "BANKS", where banks can be enabled or disabled at will, it is helpful to logically group frequencies together within respective banks and turn them on/off as needed. Ie. Critical local frequencies in a single bank, and the various remote counties in their respective banks so that, as you travel to other areas, those respective banks can be enabled. "Banks" not available-Baofeng UV-5R/UV-82, or some Japanese radios
- 8- Contact any user who utilizes banks, etc to help you with your programming needs.
